"In addition to the certificate we received for our RHS Level 3, we will receive a constant kitchen garden. This will consist of 3 deliveries, Spring (160 plants), Autumn (170 plants) and Fruit Garden (blackberry, raspberry, redcurrant, blackcurrant, gooseberry, tayberry, more strawberries and rhubarb plants). At this rate we will need to expand the garden!

About 80% of the seeds the club have planted, this year, have now germinated. Sweet peas, Verbena, carrots, beetroot, pumpkin, pan squash, marigold, nasturtiums, sweetcorn to name but a few.



The strawberry and rhubarb beds are doing well. Potting on and then transferring them to their final place are our next stages. Thanks to those who have brought seeds from us (pumpkins and Cosmos flowers). These are still available to buy from the office for a donation of 20p." by Mrs Jacobs
