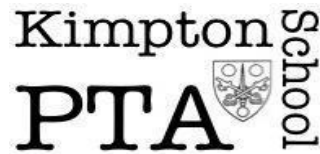
The following clubs will be running after half term and a booking form should be coming home with your child today. Please note that the cost of these sessions has increased to £3.50.
