The fund-raising effort to create a stain glass window memorial to the Late Canon Tomlinson will close at the end of November. The crowd

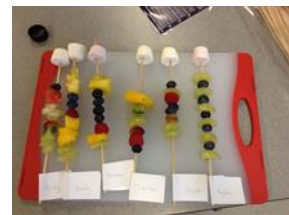
